From Goals to Action: Powering the Future with Sustainable Energy

28 October 2025 | 10:15 - 12:40 CET

The Fourteenth International Forum on Energy for Sustainable Development (IFESD-14) will take place in Skopje, North Macedonia, from 28 to 30 October 2025. It is organized by the Ministry of Energy, Mining and Mineral Resources of North Macedonia, UNDP North Macedonia, and the five United Nations Regional Commissions (UNECA, UNECE, UNECLAC, UNESCAP, and UNESCWA).

The global energy landscape stands at a critical juncture. As energy demand continues to grow and the urgency of the climate crisis deepens, advancing a just, inclusive, and sustainable energy transition has never been more essential. Action on this transition is central to achieving Sustainable Development Goal 7 (SDG 7) on affordable and clean energy and to delivering the broader 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

Against this backdrop, IFESD-14 will convene governments, international organizations, the private sector, academia, and civil society to explore solutions under the theme "From Goals to Action: Powering the Future with Sustainable Energy." The theme reflects the Forum's ambition to move from commitments to implementation and to ensure that the energy transition delivers benefits for all.

This discussion is particularly relevant, as it brings together several global priorities: expanding access to clean and affordable energy, strengthening energy security and regional connectivity, promoting innovative technologies and financing models, and ensuring that the transition is equitable and inclusive.

The Forum will open with a Plenary Session to set the tone and overall direction of the event. High-ranking government officials, representatives from international organizations, and international financial institutions will address the Forum's overarching theme "From Goals to Action: Powering the Future with Sustainable Energy" and outline pathways to align national and regional strategies with global sustainable development goals.

Building on the outcomes of IFESD-13 in Bangkok – which emphasized multilevel cooperation, youth engagement, and actionable strategies – the Plenary Session will highlight how policy, technology, finance, and partnerships can converge to accelerate progress and deliver measurable results.

In particular, the plenary session aims to:

- 1. Set the Stage for Action Frame global and regional energy challenges and opportunities within the context of SDG 7 and the 2030 Agenda.
- 2. Highlight Strategic Priorities Focus on energy security, just energy transitions, renewable deployment, digitalization, financing, and the engagement of women and youth.
- 3. Promote Collaboration and Partnerships Foster cross-sectoral dialogue and multilevel cooperation to accelerate sustainable energy initiatives.
- 4. Showcase Innovative Solutions Present examples of policies technologies, and financial strategies that drive measurable progress.
- 5. *Inspire Commitment* Encourage participants to translate discussions into concrete actions, ensuring accountability and follow-up after the Forum.

The Forum will host two High-Level Plenary Sessions under the shared theme: "From Goals to Action: Powering the Future with Sustainable Energy."
